2022 CURRENT TRIP RULES AND GUIDELINES FOR HSC CHAPTER B

- Signup begins at 10:45 AM and ends at 11:45 AM on regular scheduled meeting days
- Full Payment for a day trip is due at time of signup. Payment for overnight trips might be spread over multiple meetings
- At the **first** signup, tickets may be purchased by a member who can also purchase for their non-member spouse or significant other.
- At the **first** signup, members may also purchase tickets for other members who cannot attend the meeting
- At the **second** sign up, members can sign up for non-member. First come, first sold basis.
- On overnight trips, members may purchase a ticket for their roommate at the time of the first signup.

- Consistent with ADA travel guidelines, the Chapter "B" Trip Committee can make no determination of your fitness to travel, nor guarantee your ability to successfully manage a trip. If in doubt, please contact your doctor. Person needing individual assistance with boarding the coach, walking, dining or other personal needs, must be accompanied by an able companion. The companion must also have a ticket.
- If the trip is sold out, a wait list may be created. If a cancellation occurs, members on the "wait list" will be contacted. If there is no wait list, it will be your responsibility to find a replacement
- There is guarantee that any refund will be given. Refund depend on when your request is made and the policy of the tour company
- On the morning of the trip, numbers will be given out when you arrive at the bus boarding. The order on which you board the bus is based on your number.
- All passengers must sit in the same seat for the duration of the trip
